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There is thin ice and new ice formation in sheltered water in the eastern part of the German Baltic coast.

Western Baltic Sea

In the Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst there thin ice and new ice formation.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the northern approach to Stralsund and east of Hiddensee there is new ice and new ice formation and in places also open to very close, 5-10cm thick ice. In the eastern approach to Stralsund there is 5-10cm thick ice, very close in the port of Stralsund and close out to Palmer Ort. Some stripes of shuga are drifting in the Greifswalder Bodden and there is new ice and shuga along the coast, in the Dänische Wiek also up to 13cm thick, rafted ice. On the Pennestrom there is new ice and new ice formation, in places also very close shuga. At the coast of the Kleines Haff there is thin, partly rafted ice in places.

Outlook

New ice formation will continue. Some new ice formation can also be expected in the sheltered regions in western part of the German Baltic.

Restrictions to navigation

To Stralsund, Wolgast and the harbours in the Greifswalder Bodden only daytime navigation with pilot is allowed.
