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Further ice decrease, the ice is pressed against the northern shores.

Western Baltic Sea

On the Schlei and in Rostock there is open water. In the Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst there is very close to compact 5-10 cm thick ice with several open areas.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the northern approach to Stralsund and east of Hiddensee there is 5-15 cm thick close to compact ice, in places also fast ice; on the fairway Schaprode – Hiddensee open 3-5 cm thick ice occurs. In the port of Sassnitz there is up to 15cm thick open ice. The eastern approach to Stralsund is in most parts ice free, but at Landtief there is 5-10cm close ice. In the Greifswalder Bodden there is 5-15 cm thick close to compact ice in the northern half and in the Dänische Wiek in the south, else mostly open water. On the Peenestrom there is open water. In the Kleines Haff there is very close, 5-15 cm thick ice in the northern part, along the southern shore ice free or open water. At sea in the Pomeranian Bight there are stripes of 5-15cm thick ice drifting in northeasterly direction out of the Greifswalder Bodden

Outlook

The ice will decrease further and the northeasterly drift will intensify, further pressing the remaining ice towards the northern shores and also out of the Greifswalder Bodden..

Restrictions to navigation

To Stralsund, Wolgast and the harbours in the Greifswalder Bodden only in convoy and with pilot, only daytime navigation is allowed.
