

German Ice Report - No. 86

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Ice is melting and decreasing.

Western Baltic Sea

In the Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst there is very open rotting ice.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the northern approach to Stralsund and east of Hiddensee there is 5-10 cm thick ice, mostly in the eastern parts. On the fairway Schaprode – Hiddensee open water occurs. The port of Sassnitz is ice-free. The eastern approach to Stralsund is ice-free. In the Greifswalder Bodden there is compact 5-15 cm thick ice, mostly at the northern shores, and very open thin ice in the Dänische Wiek, else ice-free. The Peenestrom is ice-free. In the Kleines Haff there is close and rafted, 5-10 cm thick ice in the northern part, along the southern shore there is ice-free.

Outlook

At air temperatures above 0°C at night and up to 12 °C by day, the ice decrease will continue rather rapidly.

Restrictions to navigation

To Stralsund, Wolgast and the harbours in the Greifswalder Bodden only daytime navigation.
