

German Ice Report - No. 01
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New ice and thin ice is present in shallow and sheltered coastal areas, in places.

Western Baltic Sea

On the inner Schlei there is open thin ice. The Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst are partly covered with up to 5 cm thick ice.

Southern Baltic Sea

On the northern fairway to Stralsund very close new ice occurs, the sheltered regions are covered by up to 5 cm thick ice. In the Bodden waters between Hiddensee and Rügen there is close to very close, partly rafted thin ice, on the fairway open ice is drifting. In the southern part of the Greifswalder Bodden there is open to close thin ice in sheltered regions near the coast. Southern Peenestrom is mostly covered with up to 5 cm thick ice. Consolidated thin ice is present along the northern and southern coasts of the Kleines Haff.

Ice formation will continue and intensify during the next two to three days, especially in the eastern inner coastal waters.
