

German Ice Report - No. 27

Western Baltic Sea

In some small harbours there is minor new ice, shuga or slush.

Southern Baltic Sea

In some harbours there is minor new ice, shuga or slush. On the southern Peenestrom there is new ice and ice formation, in places. In the Kleines Haff there is very open thin brash ice at the northern coast as well as new ice and ice formation.

Outlook

At light frost degrees marginal new ice formation is possible in sheltered coastal regions. During Sunday and Monday the possibility of ice formation will increase.

Restrictions to navigation

From 07.02.2013 18:00: Only daytime navigation is allowed in the northern approach to Stralsund (including Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst), in the southern Peenestrom and in Kleines Haff.
