

## **German Ice Report - No. 32**

2013-02-14

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### **North Sea**

On the North-Frisian coast there is open new ice in the harbour of Tönning, and very open new ice at Eiderdamm.

### **Western Baltic Sea**

On the inner Schlei and in the inner Flensburger Förde as well as in the harbours of Neustadt, Wismar and Rostock there is new ice, in places. New ice occurs near the coasts of the Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst.

### **Southern Baltic Sea**

In the Bodden waters between Hiddensee and Rügen there is very close to very open new ice in the sheltered bays. In the marginal areas of the Greifswalder Bodden and on the southern Peenestrom there is new ice and ice formation. On the northern Peenestrom minor new ice and shuga occurs, in places. In the Kleines Haff there is thin brash ice frozen with new ice at the northern coast, else new ice and ice formation.

### **Outlook**

At daily air temperatures around the freezing point, light frost degrees at night, and weak winds from southeasterly directions, no major ice formation will occur during the next three to four days.

### **Restrictions to navigation**

**From 07.02.2013 18:00:** Only daytime navigation is allowed in the northern approach to Stralsund (including Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst), in the southern Peenestrom and in Kleines Haff.
