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North Sea

On the North-Frisian coast there is open water in the harbour of Tönning and very open new ice at Eiderdamm.

Western Baltic Sea

On the inner Schlei as well as in the harbour of Wismar there is new ice, in places. New ice occurs near the coasts of the Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Bodden waters between Hiddensee and Rügen there is close to very open new ice in the sheltered bays. In the marginal areas of the Greifswalder Bodden and on the southern Peenestrom there is new ice, in places. In the Kleines Haff there is thin brash ice frozen with new ice close to the northern coast.

Outlook

At daily air temperatures up to +5°C and temperatures around 0°C at night, ice remnants will melt within the next five days. By the end of next week, ice formation may start again in the sheltered and shallow coastal waters.

Restrictions to navigation

From 07.02.2013 18:00: Only daytime navigation is allowed in the northern approach to Stralsund (including Bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst), in the southern Peenestrom and in Kleines Haff.
