Compact ice is still present in the northernmost parts of the Bight of Greifswald and of Kleines Haff.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Bight of Greifswald there is compact 5-15 cm thick brash ice in the northernmost area, however, close to the coast there is very open ice, in places. The Peenestrom is ice-free, but some rotten ice is present in Achterwasser. In Kleines Haff there is compact, partly ridged, about 10 cm thick ice at the north-eastern coast, else ice-free.

Outlook

Ice remnants in the eastern coastal waters will melt within the next three to four days.

Careful navigation is still requesting due to dispersed buoys and in the ice covered areas.
