German Ice Report - No. 28 2014-02-21

Very close ice is still present in the north-east part of Kleines Haff.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Bight of Greifswald there is open 5-10 cm thick brash ice in the northernmost area. Peenestrom is ice-free, but some rotten ice is present in Achterwasser. In Kleines Haff there is very close, partly rafted, 5-10 cm thick ice at the north-eastern coast, else ice-free.

Outlook

At daily air temperatures up to 9°C and temperatures around 2°C at night, ice remnants will melt within the next two to three days.

Careful navigation is still requesting due to dispersed buoys and in the ice covered areas.

This is the last German Ice Report for the time being.
