

German Ice Report - No. 04
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In some ports there is few, thin ice. The Bodden waters are covered by close ice or fast ice.

North Sea

In the port of Tönning 5 cm thick very open ice occurs. The offshore terminals of Eiderdamm are covered by close to very close ice, else there is open water. The Lister Tief is ice free.

Western Baltic Sea

The Schlei is covered by open 3-4 cm thick ice. In Heiligenhafen and Neustadt there is open water with rand ice or brash ice. The port of Rostock is covered by close 5-10 cm thick new ice, further out towards Warnemünde thin new ice occurs occasionally. The region south of Zingst and Darß is covered by very close 12-15 cm thick level ice and fast ice. The Bodden between Rügen and Hiddensee is completely covered by 5-15 cm thick consolidated or fast ice.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Greifswalder Bodden mostly open water occurs, in sheltered areas also close ice. Ice thicknesses lie between 5 cm and 10 cm. The Dänische Wieck and the Greifswalder Wiek are covered by close to very close 12-30 cm thick ice. On the Peene River open 7 cm thick ice occurs. The Peenestrom is completely covered by fast ice, ice thicknesses vary between 8 and 15 cm. In the Kleines Haff there is 5-12 cm thick fast ice.

Outlook

The ice situation will not change significantly until tomorrow.
