

German Ice Report - No. 01
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There is new and thin ice in some harbours and in shallow and sheltered coastal waters. The Peene River, southern Peene Strait and the Szczecin Lagoon are covered by very close ice.

North Sea

Close to List, new ice forms in the Wadden Sea. In the sea area close to Eiderdamm and in the offshore terminal there is open water. The harbour of Bremen is covered by very open new ice.

Western Baltic Sea

The ports of Flensburg and Schleswig are covered by thin new ice, in the city-port of Rostock there is open water. The Bodden of Zingst-Darß is in placed covered by thin new ice. The fairway to Stralsund is covered by very close ice from Vierendehlrinne to Palmer Ort. In Neuendorf there is open ice. In the fairway to Wolgast there is close, 3-10 cm thick ice in the ports Peenemünde, Freest and Karlshagen.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Dänische Wieck and the Greifswalder Wiek up to 5 cm thick ice has formed in places. The Peene River is covered by very close, up to 5 cm thick ice. In the southern Peene Strait and the Szczecin Lagoon very close, up to 15 cm thick ice occurs.

Outlook

In shallow and sheltered areas, further new ice may form.
