There is new and thin ice in some harbours and in shallow and sheltered coastal waters. The Peene River, southern Peene Strait and the Szczecin Lagoon are covered by very close ice.

North Sea

Close to List, some new ice forms in the Wadden Sea. The sea area close to Eiderdamm and the offshore terminal are ice free. The harbour of Bremen is covered by very open new ice.

Western Baltic Sea

The ports of Flensburg and Schleswig are covered by thin new ice, on the river Warnow there is very open ice or open water. The Bodden of Zingst-Darß is in placed covered by thin new ice. The fairway to Stralsund is covered by close to very close ice from Barhöft to Palmer Ort. In Neuendorf there is open water.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Dänische Wieck and the Greifswalder Wiek there is close to very close, up to 10 cm thick ice. The port of Thiessow is also covered by ice. The Peene River is covered by very close, up to 10 cm thick ice. In the southern Peene Strait and the Szczecin Lagoon very close, up to 15 cm thick ice occurs.

Outlook

In shallow and sheltered areas, further new ice may form.
