

German Ice Report - No. 03

There is thin ice in some ports and in shallow and sheltered coastal waters. The Peene River, southern Peene Strait and the Szczecin Lagoon are covered by very close ice.

North Sea

Ice free.

Western Baltic Sea

In Flensburg and Schleswig open water with few ice floes occurs, the port of Wismar is covered by thin open ice and on the river Warnow there is very open ice or open water. The Bodden of Zingst-Darß is in placed covered by thin new ice. The fairway to Stralsund is covered by open to very close, up to 10 cm thick ice from Vierendehlrinne to Palmer Ort. In Neuendorf there is open water.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Greifswalder Bodden there is open, up to 5 cm thick ice in the Dänische Wieck and the Greifswalder Wiek, an ice cover occurs in the port of Thiessow and open water in the port Ladebow. The Peene River is covered by very close, 5-10 cm thick ice. In the southern Peene Strait and the Szczecin Lagoon very close ice or fast ice occurs, up to 15 cm thick.

Outlook

No new ice formation, the ice will melt slowly.
