The ice is melting.

**Western Baltic Sea**

Flensburg is ice free. In Schleswig there is very open ice in the Kleine Breite. The port of Wismar is covered by thin open ice, on the river Warnow there is open water or ice free. The Bodden of Zingst-Darß is in placed covered by thin melting ice. The fairway to Stralsund is covered by open to very close, 5 cm thick ice from Vierendehlrinne to Palmer Ort. In Neuendorf there is open water.

**Southern Baltic Sea**

In the Greifswalder Bodden there is very open, up to 5 cm thick ice in the Dänische Wieck and the Greifswalder Wiek, and an ice cover occurs in the port of Thiessow. The Peene River is covered by very close, 5-10 cm thick ice. In the southern Peene Strait there is open to very close, 6-11 cm thick ice and the Szczecin Lagoon is covered by very close ice or fast ice, up to 15 cm thick.

**Outlook**

No new ice formation, the ice will melt slowly.
