The ice melts slowly.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Bodden of Darß-Zingst, thin ice occurs in places. Neuendorf is ice free. Greifswald-Wiek is ice free, in the Dänische Wiek open water occurs. The southern Peene Strait is partly covered by very close, 3-10 cm thick ice south of Wolgast but there are also ice free areas. In the Szczecin Lagoon there is open water and close ice, mostly thinner than 15 cm.

Outlook

Temperatures vary around the freezing point. Overnight, new ice formation is possible in shallow and sheltered waters.
