Light new ice formation.

Southern Baltic Sea

The Bodden of Darß-Zingst is ice free. In the harbour of Neuendorf some new ice has formed. In Greifswald-Wiek and in the Dänische Wiek very open, up to 5 cm thick ice occurs. The southern Peene Strait is partly covered by very close, 3-11 cm thick ice south of Wolgast but there are also ice free areas. In the Szczecin Lagoon there is mostly open water in the eastern and close ice in the western part, mostly thinner than 15 cm.

Outlook

New ice formation is expected in shallow and sheltered waters due to light to moderate frost with light to moderate easterly winds.

Restrictions

The southern Peene Strait, the Achterwasser and the Kleines Haff are closed for ship traffic.
