# German Ice Report - No. 18

Some new ice has formed.

## Western Baltic Sea

In the port of Schleswig new ice has formed. The Bodden of Zingst-Darß is covered by thin new ice in places and in the Bodden between Rügen and Hiddensee, new ice has formed close to the coast.

### Southern Baltic Sea

In Greifswald-Wiek and in the Dänische Wiek close to very close, up to 6 cm thick ice occurs. The southern fairway to Stralsund is covered by very open new ice between Palmer Ort-Freesendorfer Haken and Osttief. In the Peene Strait there is new ice in the entrance and south of Wolgast, mostly close to very close, 2-13 cm thick ice occurs. In the Szczecin Lagoon there is predominantly open water in the eastern and close ice in the western part, mostly thinner than 15 cm.

## Outlook

New ice formation is expected in shallow and sheltered waters due to light to moderate frost with light to moderate easterly winds.

### Restrictions

The southern Peene Strait, the Achterwasser and the Kleines Haff are closed for ship traffic.
