

German Ice Report - No. 30

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Only little ice is still present.

Western Baltic Sea

The Bodden of Zingst-Darß, the Bodden between Rügen and Hiddensee and the Strelasund are ice free.

Southern Baltic Sea

In sheltered areas close to the coast of the Greifswalder Bodden, little rest ice occurs in places, else the area is ice free. In the Peene Strait there are open water and ice free areas north of Wolgast. South of Wolgast, open water with patches of close to very close, 3-10 cm thick ice occurs. In the Szczecin Lagoon there is mostly open water with patches of very open ice and ice free areas in the south-western parts and close to very close, 5-10 cm thick ice in the northern and eastern parts.

Outlook

Mild temperatures will continue melting the ice.

Restrictions

The southern Peene Strait, the Achterwasser and the Kleines Haff are closed for ship traffic. Only daytime navigation is allowed in the northern approach to Stralsund (including Bodden waters west), eastern approach to Stralsund from Landtief B to the ports in the Greifswalder Bodden and Stralsund and in the northern Peenestrom. Begin and end of daytime navigation can be obtained on VHF: Warnemuende traffic center, Stralsund traffic channel 67 and Wolgast traffic channel 09.
