

German Ice Report - No. 31

Only little ice is still present in the Szczecin Lagoon.

Western Baltic Sea

Ice free.

Southern Baltic Sea

In sheltered areas close to the coast of the Greifswalder Bodden, little rest ice may occur else the area is ice free. The Peene Strait is ice free. In the Szczecin Lagoon there is only little ice left along the northern and easternmost coast.

Outlook

Mild temperatures will continue and the little remaining ice will disappear soon.

Restrictions

The southern Peene Strait, the Achterwasser and the Kleines Haff are closed for ship traffic. Only daytime navigation is allowed in the northern approach to Stralsund (including Bodden waters west), eastern approach to Stralsund from Landtief B to the ports in the Greifswalder Bodden and Stralsund and in the northern Peenestrom. Begin and end of daytime navigation can be obtained on VHF: Warnemuende traffic center, Stralsund traffic channel 67 and Wolgast traffic channel 09.
