

German Ice Report - No. 32
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Western Baltic Sea
Ice free.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Szczecin Lagoon there is only little ice left along the northern and easternmost coast.

Outlook

The little remaining ice will disappear soon. The next report will be issued when ice restarts to grow.

Restrictions

Although the ice is disappearing, restrictions are still valid: The southern Peene Strait, the Achterwasser and the Kleines Haff are closed for ship traffic. Only daytime navigation is allowed in the northern approach to Stralsund (including Bodden waters west), eastern approach to Stralsund from Landtief B to the ports in the Greifswalder Bodden and Stralsund and in the northern Peenestrom. Begin and end of daytime navigation can be obtained on VHF: Warnemuende traffic center, Stralsund traffic channel 67 and Wolgast traffic channel 09.
