

German Ice Report - No. 22

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The ice disappears gradually.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the Darß-Zingster Bodden there is locally open water. Between Rügen and Hiddensee open water and thin open, rotten ice occur. For the Strelasund no actual information is available. In the Greifswalder Bodden there is in the western part open thin ice, else it is mostly ice free. In the southern Peene Strait there is very open, thin ice and open water. In the German part of the Szczecin Lagoon, open thin ice occurs in the southern parts.

Outlook

The remaining ice drifts to the western coasts.

Restrictions:

From 02.03.2018: Minimum ice class E1 and 1000 kw is needed for the southern Peenestrom and on the Kleines Haff. In addition only daytime navigation is allowed for the eastern approach to Stralsund from buoy "Landtief B" to the ports of the Greifswalder Bodden and to Stralsund. Begin and end of daytime navigation can be obtained on VHF channels 67 (Stralsund traffic) and 09 (Wolgast traffic) at the Warnemuende traffic center.
