

German Ice Report - No. 26
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New ice has formed.

North Sea:

In the area around Sylt open water occurs locally. In the harbour of Tönning very close ice and further out very open ice and open water occur.

Western Baltic Sea:

In Flensburg, Schleswig and Heiligenhafen open water occurs.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the harbour of Rostock open new ice is present. The Darss-Zingster Bodden Chain is mostly covered by very open, close and very close thin ice. Between Rügen and Hiddensee there is close to very close and locally very open ice up to 10 cm thick. The Strelasund is covered by close to very close ice in the north and by open water in the south. In the Greifswalder Bodden there is a belt of open to very close ice at the south-western coast, else there is very open and close thin or new ice. On the southern Peene Strait, close to very close new ice has formed. In the German part of the Szczecin Lagoon, there is locally open to close ice.

Outlook

There may be light new ice formation in shallow and sheltered areas.
