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The ice coverage has decreased.

Western Baltic Sea

In Flensburg and Heiligenhafen open water occurs.

Southern Baltic Sea

The Darss-Zingster Bodden Chain is covered by close ice in the west, else it is ice free. Between Rügen and Hiddensee there is mostly very open, 5 cm thick ice and open water. The Strelasund is mostly ice free. In the Greifswalder Bodden there is a belt of very open ice at the south-western coast, else it is mostly ice free. In the sea area off Rügen, open water occurs in Sassnitz. The Peene Strait is mostly ice free. In the German part of the Szczecin Lagoon, there is locally close ice, up to 10 cm thick.

Outlook

The ice coverage further decreases.

Restrictions:

From 20.03.2018: Minimum ice class E1 and 1000 kw is needed for the Kleines Haff.
