

German Ice Report - No. 01

North Sea coast

New ice is present in places in the Northfrisian Wadden sea with some thicker ice of 10-15cm thickness around Sylt and in the Tönning harbour. Open new ice is present also on the river Elbe at Stadersand.

Western Baltic Sea

On the Schlei there is open 5-10cm thick ice. Open water with new ice is present in the harbours of Heiligenhafen, Neustadt and Wismar. The bodden waters south of Darß and Zingst: have close to compact ice, up to 15cm thick. At the coast of Zingst there is open water.

Southern Baltic Sea

In the inner waters north of Stralsund there is compact new ice in places and close, up to 15cm thick ice at Neuendorf port. At Stralsund there is very open new ice. In the Greifswalder Bodden there is close to compact new ice around Greifswald and very open new ice in the northwest. On the Peenestrom there is 5-10cm thick ice to Wolgast and further in to Anklam mostly compact, up to 15cm thick ice. In Kleines Haff there is very close ice with 3-15cm thickness.

Outlook

Further ice formation is expected the coming days.
