

German Ice Report - No. 03

North Sea coast

In the Northfrisian Wadden sea there is open water with thin ice present around Amrum.

Western Baltic Sea

In sheltered areas east of Wismar there is open water with new ice in places. In the Bodden waters south of Darss and Zingst there is very close new or thin ice, but also areas of open water. In sheltered places around Ruegen and out to Hiddensee there is new ice of varying concentration

Southern Baltic Sea

In sheltered bays of the Greifswalder Bodden there is close new ice in places. On the Peenestrom there is thin ice with varying concentration. In the western part of the Szczecin Lagoon, there is close to very close ice in the north, partly thicker than 5 cm. Open water in the south.

Outlook

Temperatures will raise to values above 5 °C in most parts and night temperatures above 0°C are expected at the whole coast during the next days. The ice will melt, but in the east remnants can stay even over the weekend.
